


On 11 March 2020 the World Health Organization characterized COVID-19 as a pandemic.




On 15 March 2020 the Government of Lebanon, and in an effort to contain coronavirus, declared a "state of medical emergency", including partial lockdown.





Except as detailed above, LCEC offices in the Ministry will be closed;
