The WEC Lebanon Committee is hosted by the Lebanese Center for Energy Conservation (LCEC), offering a platform for the development of the national committee.

The WEC secretariat is supported by a consulting board made of 5 members.

The Consulting Board is selected by the General Assembly (active members) for a period of 2 years.

5 WEC INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITIES

WORLD ENERGY CONGRESS

The World Energy Congress is a triennial event and is the world's main energy event. It provides a platform for energy leaders and experts in all aspects of the sector to gather and address the challenges and opportunities both for energy suppliers and users. The Congress has been staged in over 20 cities across the world and the 24th World Energy Congress will take place in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates in 2019.





FUTURE ENERGY LEADERS

The Council's community of young professionals is a network of exceptional individuals from across the globe who represent the different players the energy sectors is composed of, including government, energy industry, academia, civil society and social entrepreneurs.

The Council's Future Energy Leaders' programme (FEL-100) is designed to help shape, inspire and grow energy leaders of tomorrow. It serves as a platform for engaging a limited number of ambitious young professionals in national, regional and international activities and events.

The limitation of the size of the group to 100 participants allows the self-development of outstanding young professionals and every year 35 Future Energy Leaders are invited to join the Council's FEL-100 programme and become part of the exclusive global network of tomorrow's energy leaders. Nominations are accepted from National Member Committees, Patrons, Global Partners, as well as external stakeholders.

6 WEC LEBANON ACTIVITIES

The WEC's Lebanon member committee has commenced its activities at an official gathering on 9 July 2013 in the capital Beirut.

National events are organized regularly by the WEC Lebanon Committee. Activities aim to share knowledge and best practices, update members on the latest World Energy Council studies, and be actively involved in the energy sector in Lebanon.

WEC CASUAL GATHERINGS

The WEC Lebanon Committee organizes several casual gatherings for its members throughout the year. The purpose of the gatherings is to allow the WEC members to interact among themselves and with the secretariat of the WEC Lebanon Committee and to discuss other topics of interest to the WEC members. In each gathering, a guest invitee is present to elaborate more on the ongoing projects taking place in the country, along with the LCEC team working on the pertaining files.

INTERNATIONAL BEIRUT ENERGY FORUM

The International Beirut Energy Forum (IBEF) is one of the largest energy events in Lebanon and Middle East dedicated to sustainable energy projects and issues. Since 2013, the WEC Lebanon Committee has become the main sponsor of the IBEF and shows an active participation to all its activities. The WEC Lebanon Committee offers a free of charge entrance to all its members as the event is the main yearly platform to discuss all topics related to renewable energy, energy efficiency, and green buildings.

The WEC Lebanon Committee seeks to maximize the benefits of this event to its members. Every year, the Committee has a strategic booth in the exhibition hall to promote WEC's main activities and present other opportunities to the WEC members, such as trainings and seminars.

WEC ACTIVITIES

WORLD ENERGY CONGRESS

The WEC Lebanon Committee plays a major role at the World Energy Congress hosted by the World Energy Council. Since 1924, the triennial congress is the world's largest and most influential energy event covering all aspects of the energy agenda. It offers a unique opportunity for participants to better understand energy issues and solutions from a global perspective.

At the World Energy Congress Istanbul in 2016, there were more than 250 speakers from 100 countries, 5,500 delegates from 151 countries and 50 session in 4 days. The WEC Lebanon Committee along with a delegation from its members attended this event and its different activities.

SEMINARS-BILATERAL COOPERATION PROGRAM-CHINA

The Ministry of Energy and Water and the Chinese Embassy in Lebanon initiated bilateral cooperations to strengthen the partnership between China and Lebanon in the clean energy sector. LCEC, being the national focal point of the clean energy sector in Lebanon, gives the priority to the WEC Lebanon members to attend different seminars in China, which tackle a wide range of topics that are of major importance to the development of the energy sector in Lebanon.

ECOMONDO-ITALY

Ecomondo, the largest event in the Euro-Mediterranean area for advanced and sustainable technologies for processing and recycling all kinds of waste is supported by the Italian Ministry of the Environment, Land, and Sea. The WEC Lebanon Committee gives the chance for its members to take part in this event.
